- 2. Presentation abstract must contain: brief summary of purpose / content of the presentation, its relevance to OT, and specific learning objectives. (Maximum 150 words)
- **3.** A brief (Maximum 150 words) biographical overview for <u>each</u> presenter. This will be used for the introduction of your presentation at conference.
- **4.** All presentations must be evidenced based.
